### WHEN:

**Monday, 9<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> November, 2009** (see Calendar below).

### MATCHPLAY:

**To be played at Valley View** in pools of 8 (minimum 6) players in round robin, by random draw and 4 rounds over 2 days. All players start from the first hole from 8.00am, then at intervals of seven minutes. Subject to the number of pools, the first 2 players from each pool plus next best players from all pools to build a field of 32 to play the knockout rounds, winning players to form pool A, losing players to form pool B, continuing to play knockout to a final. Women will play together in the same format, subject to the number of entries, in pools of 6 (maximum of 8). Knockout rounds to be seeded, based on percentages from round robin. Odd placed seeds to form top half of the draw while even placed seeds form the bottom half – for example, first seed cannot play second seed until the final, if neither are knocked out beforehand.

### STROKE-PLAY:

**9 hole Championship (Glanville Hall) and**

**Australian International Open Championship (Valley View)**

Played as 2 rounds of 9 holes (**Glanville Hall**) and 2 rounds of 18 holes (**Valley View**) of strokeplay each day, played in 4's, men and women separate in alternating groups; All players start from 1<sup>st</sup> hole, starting 8.00am, then at intervals of 7 minutes;

- for Rounds 1 and 2, based on random draw;
- for Rounds 3 and 4, based on Rounds 1 & 2 scores, lowest last.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Round each day will start at 11.00am approx.

If scores for overall Champions are tied after 4 rounds, sudden death play-offs will be played starting from 1<sup>st</sup> hole at Glanville Hall, and 13<sup>th</sup> hole at Valley View, and continuing therefrom. All other ties for awards will be determined by count-back.

### CATEGORIES:

Men and Women in separate Divisions. Subject to there being at least 8 players in each Division, Divisions will be:

	<b>Men</b>	<b>Women</b>
A Division –	Handicap 0 or less;	Handicap -3 or less
B Division –	Handicap -1 to - 4	Handicap -4 to -8
C Division –	Handicap -5 or more. Handicap -9 or more	

If there are fewer than 8 players in any Division, Division's limits will be adjusted. Divisions may be merged.

### AWARDS:

Best aggregate score, man or woman, of winner of all three Triple Crown events will win the Triple Crown trophy.

Championship Perpetual and individual place trophies will be awarded at the gala presentation dinner. The same player may win both Overall and Divisional Championships.

Awards for each event for the Triple Crown for both men and women will be:

- Overall Champions, Runners-up, and 3rd place based on gross scores;
- Winners, Runners-up and 3rd place of each Division, based on gross scores.

Awards for Holes in One and nearest the pins will be made and presented at the venue at the end of play of each event.

**RULES:** The Championships will be conducted under the Rules of Pitch and Putt, 2008/9, as endorsed by APPA, based on the Rules of the Federation of International Pitch and Putt Associations (FIPPA), and where not covered therein, by the Rules of Golf. Local Rules (if any) for each venue will be provided at the venue.

**DISPUTES:** Any disputes will be referred to and resolved by the Competition Match Committee. No dispute shall be entertained later than 15 minutes after the end of the disputant player's round.

**PRACTICE:** Entrants may practice all day prior to the event as designated by the event calendar. No practice will be allowed once the event begins at each venue. Practice during or between rounds will result in instant disqualification. (FIPPA Rule 2.)

**SOCIAL GAME:** 2.30pm, Monday 9th November - 4 ball Ambrose. Shotgun start. Entry \$10
